

# User Manual Paddock Wizard

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### Greeting

Welcome to the Paddock Wizard user manual! We are pleased that you have chosen our product. The Paddock Wizard was developed to give you a safe and good organized storage solution for your valuable motorcycle accessories.

#### Introduction

This user manual was created to help you install, start up and properly use the Paddock Wizard. Please read these instructions carefully before you start using them and keep them. It contains important information about safety and optimal use of your Paddock Wizard.

This operating manual is based on the applicable standards and regulations in the European Union. If you use Paddock Wizard abroad, please also note the country-specific guidelines and laws. If you pass the Paddock Wizard on to other people, be sure to also pass on the operating instructions.

The nameplate and sticker on the Paddock Wizard must not be removed.

#### Overview of the product and intended use

The Paddock Wizard is the answer to the challenges of storing high-quality motorcycle accessories. This product offers a compact and sturdy storage solution in less than one square meter of space. With Paddock Wizard you can organize and store:

- Up to 4 rims
- Your leather suit
- Your helmet
- Your gloves
- Spray cans
- paper roll
- Additional accessories such as tire pressure gauges that can easily be stored on the storage tray.

In addition to its storage function, the Paddock Wizard has practical features including:

• A helmet holder with an integrated fan that supplies fresh air to the helmet with an air flow of 790 liters per minute to reduce moisture.



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- A glove holder that can also be supplied with air.

The Paddock Wizard is easy to assemble and disassamble and is perfect for ambitious racing drivers in hobby and professional sports as it is completely foldable.

Thanks to its robust construction and high-quality powder coating, the Paddock Wizard is a long-lasting companion for your motorcycle accessories. You have made an investment in quality and we are proud to offer you a first-class solution with Paddock Wizard.

#### Explanation of the signal words

The following signal words are used in this operating manual, on the Paddock Wizard itself or on the packaging:


**WARNING!** This signal word indicates a hazard with medium risk. If not avoided, it could result in serious injury or even death.

**CAUTION!** This signal word indicates a low risk. If not avoided, minor to moderate injury may result.

**NOTICE!** This signal word warns of possible property damage.

#### Scope of delivery

1x Main carrier module
3x Leg with roller including fastening screw
1x Storage tray
1x Cell phone/watch holder
2x Transport trestle
1x Suit holder pipe including fastening screw
1x rim bar
2x Cotter pins
2x Glove holder
1x Special key for round nut

#### Testing, installation and setup

1. Find a place with enough space and take the Paddock Wizard and the parts supplied with it out of the packaging. **CAUTION**! Danger of crushing due to own weight and pre-assembled parts. **WARNING!** Do not leave packaging material and protective films lying around carelessly; they can become dangerous toys for children.

**2.** Check whether the Paddock Wizard or individual parts are damaged. If this is the case, please do not use the Paddock Wizard. Contact the manufacturer or retailer who sold you the Paddock Wizard.

**3.** Attach the three included legs 1, 2 and 3 to the lower end of the main support module as shown in Figure A, using the **special key provided for the round nut, make sure that the leg with Velcro is positioned backward.** 

**NOTICE! The guide rails are different sizes, Round nut only fits on one side! NOTICE!** The hexagon socket screws on the underside of the legs are only used for guidance and force absorption and **cannot be screwed tight!** 

4. Place the Paddock Wizard in front of you and push the legs into the guides as far as they will go.

5. Slide the rim rod 4 into the guide 5 provided, fasten it with the clamping screw and splint

the ends with the included splints.

**6.** Remove the two square tubes 6 and 7 from the holding Velcro, fold them up and push them into the guide as far as they will go.



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7. Mount the clock/mobile phone holder 8 together with table 9 on pipe number 6, using the included m4

hexagon socket screws.

**8.** Screw the two glove holders 10 to the corresponding air vents 11, also using the included m4 hexagon socket screws.

9. Assemble the suit holder 12, like the legs, with the included round nut as in Figure B

10. WARNING! Make sure all electronic functions are turned off.

**11.**Connect the connection cable to an external power source, which must be protected with FI protection.

**12.**Check the electrical functions.

- Fan (left button) for ventilation of the helmet and gloves.
- Heating elements (middle button) for warming the outgoing air (only works when the fan is running) (It takes a few seconds for the air to warm up)
- Lower sockets (right button) to switch the lower sockets on and off.

# Intended use

The Paddock Wizard is specifically designed to organize and store:

- Up to 4 rims
- Your leather suit
- Your helmet
- Your gloves
- Spray cans
- paper roll
- Small utensils on the storage tray

It was developed exclusively for your private use in dry indoor rooms and is not suitable for commercial purposes. Please only use the Paddock Wizard according to the instructions in this user manual. Any other use is considered unintended and may result in damage to your Paddock Wizard or even injury. Remember, the Paddock Wizard is not a toy for children. The manufacturer or dealer assumes no liability for damage caused by improper or incorrect use.



#### safety instructions

### WARNING! Risk of injury!

- Check your Paddock Wizard before each use. Do not use it if it is damaged.
- The Paddock Wizard must be fully assembled or folded before pushing or carrying it.
- Do not climb, stand or sit on the Paddock Wizard. Do not overload the Paddock Wizard's folding arms.
- Keep the Paddock Wizard away from children and do not leave them near it unsupervised. Keep children away while setting up and assembling the Paddock Wizard. Small parts can pose a choking hazard if swallowed or inhaled.
- There is a risk of tipping if setup incorrectly.

**Warning**! Only set up and move on a firm, level surface. Make sure that the legs cannot come loose when lifting the Paddock Wizard! The lock works by loading.

- Do not change anything in the Paddock Wizard.
- Do not attach or mount the Paddock Wizard to a vehicle. Do not pull or push it with a vehicle.
- **WARNING!** When using the Paddock Wizard, it must not be left unattended! **WARNING!** When the fan is switched on, no air outlet duct may be closed. Danger of overheating/fire hazard of the fan and heating elements. **WARNING!** Under no circumstances you should reach into or insert anything into the air outlet channels.
- **WARNING!** Be careful with the air vents. Objects can fall in which could damage the fan or ignite the heating elements!
- Before switching on, check all ventilation ducts to ensure that they are free of foreign objects.
- **WARNING!** The switch on the right is for the bottom two sockets for using tire warmers. Be careful when using tire warmers as they typically do not have a separate power switch. Be sure to turn it off BEFORE placing the tire warmers, off from the tires. Otherwise there is a risk of fire.
- **WARNING!** Make sure that the main voltage corresponds to the information on the nameplate.
- The Paddock Wizard may only be connected to an external power source that has an FI circuit breaker installed.
- People with limited physical, sensory or mental abilities are not allowed to use the device unless they are supervised and instructed by a supervisor.



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- Do not use the Paddock Wizard if it is damaged. Before use, check all components of the Paddock Wizard.
- WARNING! Never plug or unplug the power cord with wet hands.
- Before connecting a consumer, make sure that the maximum load of 3200 W is not exceeded.
- The Paddock Wizard must not be connected in series and must not be operated covered. Make sure that the cable is not crushed or damaged by sharp edges. Do not pull on the supply cable.
- Keep children and animals away from the Paddock Wizard and ensure that the cable does not become a tripping hazard.
- Do not use the Paddock Wizard in poor environmental conditions such as heat, cold, high humidity and dust. Do not use the Paddock Wizard near open solvents and flammabl gases.
- **WARNING!** Immediately unplug the power plug if the Paddock Wizard comes into contact with liquids. There is a risk of fire or life-threatening electric shock.
- Never pull the power cord out of the socket by the cable; always pull on the grip surfaces of the plug.
- Do not disassemble the Paddock Wizard or attempt to repair it. The device does not contain any parts that need to be repaired by you. Stop using the item if the housing or power line is damaged.

#### **Cleaning and care**

#### A notice! Risk of damage!

If you do not clean the Paddock Wizard properly, you could cause damage to it.

- Avoid using water and aggressive or abrasive cleaning agents. You should also avoid solvents, acid or chlorine bases.
- Do not use brushes with metal or nylon bristles and avoid sharp or metallic cleaning utensils such as knives, hard spatulas or similar.
- To clean the Wizard, use a dry, soft, clean cloth. The rollers should be lubricated annually with bearing grease.



#### Storage

#### NOTICE! Risk of damage!

Storing the Paddock Wizard in damp conditions can cause rust. This could permanently and irreparably impair the functionality or carrying capacity of the Paddock Wizard. Protect the Paddock Wizard from moisture, direct sunlight and frost.

- Store the Paddock Wizard in a dry place.
- Keep the Paddock Wizard away from children.
